1 Peter Week 8 Christian Togetherness

1 Peter 2:1 Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind. 2 Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, 3 now that you have tasted that the Lord is good. 4 As you come to him, the living Stone-rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him- 5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." 7 Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone, "A stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they disobey the message-which is also what they were destined for.

 Walking in hope and holiness should make living in <u>HARMONY</u> easy, but it's not!

Spiritual Growth (v 2)

- Christian growth is in the Christian's <u>CONTROL</u>.
- The old sinful life, or the patterns of sin, must be <u>DISCARDED</u> for us to understand the new life in Christ.
- Most of our old life is <u>UNSUITABLE</u> for the Christian life.
- Our willingness to throw off these things is a picture of life that chooses to <u>WALK WORTHY</u> of the calling.
- This is a natural <u>PROCESS</u> and growth of the Spirit-filled, divine life of Christ in us.
- Strong desires and <u>AFFECTIONS</u> to the Word of God are a sure evidence of a person's being born again.
- Growth and <u>IMPROVEMENTS</u> in wisdom and grace should be the design and desire of every Christian.

God's Goodness (v3)

- Good really means <u>"GRACIOUS"</u>.
- Don't put yourself into places where former <u>TEMPTATIONS</u> hang out.
- By "laying aside", in time, you can and will gain full <u>VICTORY</u> by wearing out the temptations.
- When Satan does tempt us, he is looking to open a <u>GATE</u> to a past sin or evil.
- Peter tells us we now have a new <u>NATURE</u>, a new hope, a new birth.

- We still have an old sinful <u>FLESH</u> that needs to be put off to die.
- What holds it together for every believer is God's <u>FERVENT</u> (enthusiastic, passionate) love.

Becoming Spiritual Houses (vv 4-6)

- Today we are <u>LIVING</u> stones in the same building.
- We are living stones because Christ is not dead and was raised in <u>VICTORY</u> over death.
- We are being built into <u>SPIRITUAL</u> houses.
- We are <u>CHOSEN</u> stones.
- We are called to be a holy <u>PRIESTHOOD</u>.
- As "chosen" people, His "priesthood", God claims <u>OWNERSHIP</u> to our lives.
- We acquired great <u>VALUE</u> when we were purchased by God.

Final Thoughts

- Jesus Christ is called a stone, to denote His invincible <u>STRENGTH</u> and everlasting <u>DURATION</u>, and to teach His servants that He is their protection and security, the foundation on which they are built, and a rock of offence to all their enemies.
- Jesus Christ is the very foundation, the stone of all our <u>HOPES</u> and <u>HAPPINESS</u>.
- Jesus communicates the true <u>KNOWLEDGE</u> of God.
- > Through Christ we have <u>ACCESS</u> to the Father.
- > Through Jesus we are made <u>PARTAKERS</u> of all spiritual blessings.
- > There is a calling to be holy and <u>BLAMELESS</u>.
